## Trust the One Who is Trustworthy

Jeremiah 17:7

### CONNECT

- When was a time in your life when you were afraid? What were the circumstances? What did you do?

### BUILD

This past Sunday, Pastor Joel shared from his life story. This week, you will have an opportunity in your groups to share from your own life story. If you are intimidated by this, then feel free to share only the parts you are comfortable with. Also, in your discussion, feel free to adapt or skip over certain questions.

- What was home life like for you growing up? Did your parents and family members give you a foundation for believing in Jesus? Or was your experience quite different?
- Do you have a time in your life when you remember surrendering your life to Jesus? If so, what were the circumstances?
- What were some of the biggest challenges along your discipleship journey? When did you doubt or have serious questions about what you first believed?
- What are some scriptures that have been the most meaningful or helpful to you? What made these passages significant for you?

- Who are key individuals who have significantly impacted your life? Have you had people who have mentored or disciplined you?

- What are some key life lessons you have learned along the way? Or what biblical values have taken deep root in your life?

### APPLY

- What are some areas in your life that God is working on in this season? How do you hope to grow?
- What scriptures would be helpful for you to meditate on or memorize so these changes might really take place in your life?
- Pastor Joel talked about trusting the Lord. What are areas in your life where you believe God wants you to trust Him more? (Family, finances, future, health, struggles, obedience, relationships, etc...)

Take a few moments to pray together and to surrender these things to the Lord. He is good and completely trustworthy. It makes sense to give up control and to ask Him for help.
