Embracing Jesus' Example for Outreach

CONNECT

- Describe a person whom you would say has an extremely winsome personality. What is it about their personality and practices you find so appealing and attractive? What affect do they have on people?

STUDY

This week's message had us thinking about what we can learn about outreach from Jesus. How does 1 Corinthians 11:1 serve as a reason for us to look to Jesus' model?

So, rather than supplying scriptures for study this week, your challenge is to **think of scriptures and/or situations** where Jesus provided examples for us to follow:

- How did Jesus show us that to reach the lost we must leave our comfort zones?
- Can you think of times Jesus showed the life-altering power of listening to others?
- How did Jesus make room for people who could have been considered an interruption, but instead He treated as a divine appointment?

- What types of sacrifices did Jesus endure to make sure we were saved?

- How did Jesus demonstrate joy, peace and contentment in His ministry?

APPLY

- Which of the five points from the message is the biggest challenge for you: leaving your comfort zone? Learning to listen? Making space in your life for the lost? Making sacrifices to reach people for the gospel? Or would it be demonstrating joy, peace and contentment. What can you do to overcome your biggest hurdles?
- Why are people more prone to be drawn to people who exhibit joy, peace and contentment, rather than anger, discontent and grumpiness?
- What does it take for us to overcome staying in our comfort zones? What are your comfort zones?
- How might you change your weekly schedule to make more time and space to explore your community and develop new relationships with nonbelievers?
