CONNECT

- How was the Gospel presented to you when you first heard it? Did you respond the first time you heard the Gospel?

STUDY

In this final message of the EVERYDAY EVANGELISM series, we looked at the importance of being able to effectively share our story of coming to and knowing Christ. Typically, to present the Gospel means we are respectful and gentle, yet mindful to make sure we clearly explain the story of God’s redemptive plan. As a study assignment, here are some passages from the book of Acts where three people (Peter, Stephen and Paul) share their unique stories of experiencing the Gospel. Read them through and make any observations about what they shared.

* Peter – Acts 2 14-41

* Stephen – Acts 7:1-53

* Paul – Acts 26:1-32

* In each of these testimonies, was there enough information given about how to become a Christian?

APPLY

* Try writing out your testimony in 100 words or less.

* If you could give the story of your coming to faith in Jesus a title, what would it be?

* What are some ways you are recently seeing God’s presence and experiencing His power in your life? How can you weave these experiences into the sharing of your story?

* Why is it helpful to present the Gospel with confidence, humility and joy (as opposed to presenting it with pride, fear or a negative vibe)?

* Who are three or four spiritually disconnected people you know? Are you praying for them? Are you looking for open doors to start spiritual conversations? Are you anticipating God doing a life-transforming work?
