2020 has been a hard year with heartache and loss, tragedy and sorrow. But God wants us to learn from the past and He wants us to thank Him for being with us through hard times and good times, to remember that he never leaves us nor forsakes us. We want to share with you some news from one of our pastors:

Pastor Bruce, Kagome Lomé-

Covid-19 has paralyzed our church activities. Since March 22 (2020), the Togo government has closed all churches. We had started 2020 well and in February, a brother from church invited his classmate, Marco, to worship with us. After the service, I spoke to Marcos and presented the plan of salvation. He accepted Jesus as his Savior. He was barely a month old in faith when the church closed. Marcos is an orphan as he lost his mother at age 5 and his father at age 15. He lived with his uncle until he started drinking alcohol and drove Marcos from his home in October because of his faith. He has lived alone since that time and we have taken him under our responsibility. He is in his final year of college and Marcos needs prayers for his material and spiritual support.

My wife and I continue with door-to-door evangelism in the neighborhood. Thanks be to God, we have won some souls to Christ. We teach them the Word of God in their house. When we reach 10 members we will start with the worship again. The majority in the community are Catholics and Jehovah's Witnesses. We need your prayers.


Prayer Needs:

Message Reflection Questions

How familiar are you with the Sermon on the Mount? If you know it somewhat well, what are some of Jesus' teachings you remember from Matthew 5-7?

Are obeying the teachings found in the Sermon on the Mount the way for a person to be saved? Explain your answer and use some scripture to back up your thoughts.

Some have said that the teachings in the Sermon on the Mount are too hard to obey, so Jesus must have been speaking idealistically, not realistically. What say you? How might the conclusion of the sermon found in Matthew 7:24-27 shape your response?

Jesus is the King of His Kingdom, both now and in the future. What reasons would you give to say that Jesus is a good king? What can we expect in our lives when we put ourselves under His rule?

Read through the Sermon on the Mount, found in Matthew 5-7 (It should take you about 10-15 minutes). Which of Jesus' teachings sounds the most difficult for a person to fulfill?

The statutes of the Sermon on the Mount often feel out of reach...way too hard to fulfill. What do we need to be able to please our King, Jesus? How does He help us?

Next week we dig into the first part of Jesus's sermon, "The Beatitudes" found in Matthew 5:3-12. What's a Beatitude? (This will help get you ready for this Sunday's message!)
