- H** have Hope—endurance is the fruit of hope.








Annual Budget 2021




Tithes and Offerings, 1st Qtr 2021




Needs Giving, 1st Qtr 2021




Total Income, 2021 1st Qtr

Message Reflection Questions

Describe a time when you were extremely hungry or thirsty. How did you feel? What emotions were you experiencing? What did you do to fill your stomach or quench your thirst?

2021 1st Quarter Financial Update

(The following points refer to the tables on the back page)

Annual Budget: This is the projected amount we expect to spend this year on Church operations.

Tithes and Offerings: This is how much of our income came from the generous gifts of our church family.

Needs Giving: This is the amount of gifts that were given towards our benevolence fund.

Total Income: This is how much total income the church received. This includes tithes and offerings, needs giving, rental fees from facility usage, CDA Bookstore sales, etc. This is a slightly better start than in 2020 and 2019!

Total Expenses: This is how much the church spent during the 1st quarter. This includes all church expenses: operations, personnel, etc. This is less than we spent in the same period for 2020 and 2019.

Surplus/ Deficit: This shows whether we have gained enough income to cover our expenses. So far, we have had to use **\$10,922** out of reserves to cover our expenses. It is typical for our church to run a deficit through May, so this is not a cause for concern. Historically our tithes and offerings are low at the beginning of the year and grow later in the year. Our expenses during this period have averaged out to \$14,767, which is somewhat lower than for the same period in 2020 and 2019.
