The “Tea Up and Fill Our Cup” campaign was a great success! Due to so many generous supporters, such as CDA Bible, we actually met and exceeded our goal of \$25,000.00! It has been a blessing to serve our vulnerable seniors and their caregivers, in an even greater capacity, during this very difficult time.




