### *Reaching & Teaching*

After another year of tightening, then loosening, of government restrictions, we are grateful that life has mostly returned to some normalcy here in Cordoba. God did bless us during the past year of COVID restrictions. Eric was able to complete his Association of Certified Biblical Counselors (ACBC) certification (and Danica has advance in her ACBC certification as well) which opened up opportunities for Spanish biblical counseling for Eric in Latin America. We have also grown closer as a family unit, spending quality time together, homeschooling, etc. We have also grown closer to our neighbor, Flavia, as well as our teammates, the Wrights, who are all within our smaller COVID-safe circle.

As restrictions lessened, our daily lives got busier. That is what we are here for, and we are grateful for the ministry God has given us! Eric traveled to several churches throughout Argentina for training and encouragement. He traveled to San Juan and Chaco in July to train leaders and church members in biblical counseling. There are so many amazing stories about how God is working there!

We also continue to be super involved with the biblical counseling ministry through our church. Eric completed the extensive application process to make our church a center for biblical counseling and training. We are anticipating hearing soon about the ACBC board decision and approval. He also has been doing counseling supervision, one-on-one counseling with other men, assistant teaching online seminary courses in English and Spanish on biblical counseling, and teaching and preaching at our church.

Danica is also enjoying learning and growing as she is in the last phase of the ACBC certification. She is counseling several other women weekly as a part of this process. She loves seeing the work of the Holy Spirit in changing hearts through God's Word and the Gospel! She is seeing God work in situations from marriage conflict, to abuse, to fighting pride, and more. And of course, she is learning more and more Spanish through it all!

We are also gearing up for our coming ministry and connection trip to the States! We will be in 11 states over a four-month period from November 2021 to March 2022. We are looking forward to seeing friends, family and new and current supporting churches. That said, praise God for our recent approval as permanent residents of Argentina!

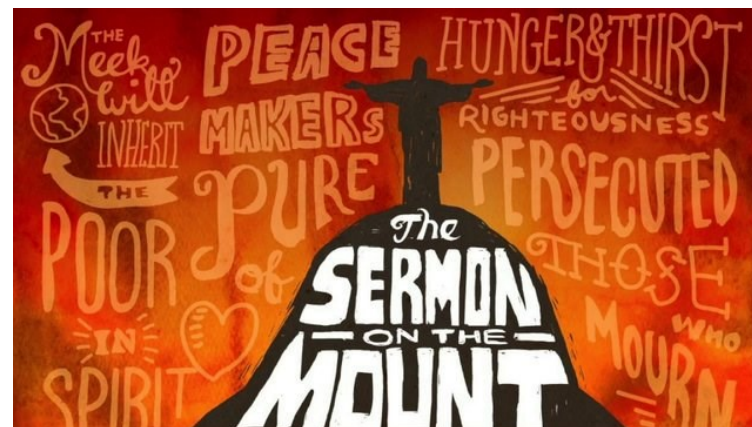
#### **Prayer Requests:**

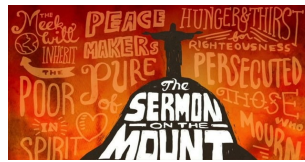

## Matthew 7: 24-29 What Serves as the Foundation for My Life?

Jesus appeals to his listeners to embrace all God has in store for them:

s\_\_\_\_\_ and d\_\_\_\_\_!

When it comes to salvation, it's not that we just believe facts about Jesus, but that we put our *complete trust* in the p\_\_\_\_\_ and the p\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus.

THE CHALLENGE: to embrace a personal relationship with Jesus from which our l\_\_\_\_\_ and o\_\_\_\_\_ to Him spring forth.

Jesus' warnings are always rooted in His g\_\_\_\_\_ | \_\_\_\_\_ for us.

## Message Reflection Questions

Read over Jesus' words in Matthew 7:24-27. What is the main point Jesus is trying to make? What makes these words a fitting conclusion to his sermon?

Can you think of a time you constructed something (small or large), only to have it blown over or washed out because it wasn't as secure as you thought?

The last part of Matthew 7 is a series of warnings offered by Jesus. Why was Jesus compelled to speak in such challenging language?

Look at Matthew 7:24. What are the two conditions that must be met for a person to be described as one who builds their life on the rock?

How are the two houses described by Jesus similar? How are they different? What does it take to reveal the differences between the houses?

What types of "storms" show up in our lives that reveal the type of foundation we've built our life on? What does it look like if we've built our life on Jesus' words? What does it look like if we've ignored Jesus' instruction?

What is the ultimate "storm" that each person must be concerned with after death? (Check out Hebrews 9:27) How does this apply to what Jesus was teaching in Matthew 7:24-27?

Read Matthew 7:28-29. What would make Jesus' teaching so "astonishing" to those who heard him speak?
