- What is the purpose of having a statement of core beliefs?
- What problems might arise when a statement of belief is overly lengthy and full of secondary belief issues, rather than focusing on the core essentials of the Gospel?
- What problems might arise when a statement of belief tries to be too brief and compact, leaving out key Gospel truths?
- How does having a concise, yet robust statement of belief help a church body remain unified?
- Unity has a very high value to God. How does Jesus' prayer in John 17:20-23 reflect the importance of unity among Christians?
- How does 1 Corinthians 1:10 exhort Christians to pursue unity?
- How do we determine which doctrines are "hills to die on" and which doctrines aren't?
