INDISPENSABLE: God's Plan of Rescue

- God is a god of peace, light, and life, who decides to enter into chaos personally for the sake of bringing life and abundance where there was only chaos and death.

- Three things Creation teaches us about God's character:
 - ◇ He confronts and pushes back chaos and darkness
 - ◇ He brings forth life
 - ◇ He gives that life a purpose

- Implications:
 - ◇ God's Plan of Rescue is meant to restore humans to divine vocation
 - ◇ God's people are supposed to actively pursue divine vocation

Message Reflection Questions

Read Psalm 1 and discuss the following:

1. What does it mean to delight in the Yahweh's instruction?

2. How is it that delighting in Yahweh's instructions bring blessing?

3. How does this relate to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden? Did they delight in Yahweh's instruction? Did they fulfill their divine vocation? How, or how not?

4. How does the Shoot of Jesse in Isaiah 11 obey the attitude of Psalm 1? Did He fulfill His divine vocation? How, or how not?

5. What does all this mean for us?
