

On Site for Seniors

Our mission is to meet the needs of seniors and their caregivers by sharing the love of God through care, compassion, and connection.

What We're Doing: The Bennett House Adult Day Center is open for those in need with careful monitoring and all staff/volunteers/guests using heightened sanitizing routines. This is declared an 'essential' service for Veterans and others as 'hero' family caregivers are even more in need of respite at this challenging time. Our staff and volunteers have reached out to meet unique needs: delivering food, making pharmacy trips, calling to support caregivers, providing social support to homebound seniors through phone or video visits, educating about safest practices, delivering telemedicine equipment, and holding our weekly prayer meeting on a group conference line.

Expansion of Telemedicine: As one of the few medical practices that has already been using telehealth, we have offered the use of our equipment and experience to many other medical, home health agencies and consultants in our area. We 'lend out' pre-loaded, portable devices (smart phones, tablets, etc.) so that persons who do not have a computer can still access 'live video visits' directly with our medical practitioners from the comfort and safety of home!

We have been blessed with recent donations of used i-phones and tablets to help us reach those in need of telehealth visits. But the needs are much more!
