We have been busy with meetings, Tammi has been homeschooling the kids (she started early since we know we will be traveling and settling in to a new home soon), and we have been trying to pack all our belongings once again, among many other details.

Please pray for safety, that God would keep us secure in our travels (more than a 30 hour drive), to avoid accidents or mishaps with crime and the like.

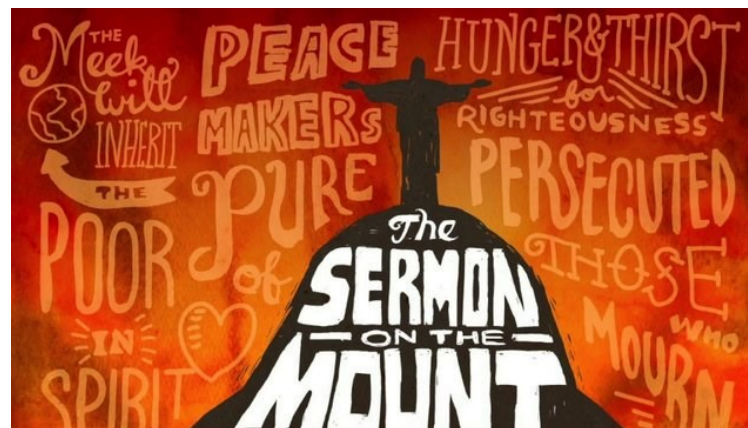

### Three things to watch out for regarding false teachers:

1. Does the teacher's life m\_\_\_\_\_ what they teach...or more importantly, what the B\_\_\_\_\_ teaches?
2. Messing with the c\_\_\_\_\_ t\_\_\_\_\_ of Christianity
3. A propensity toward c\_\_\_\_\_ and d\_\_\_\_\_

### Three basic things to pay attention to:

1. The m\_\_\_\_\_ of l\_\_\_\_\_ a teacher displays
2. The c\_\_\_\_\_ of their teaching
3. The e\_\_\_\_\_ of their teaching

### Message Reflection Questions

- Read through Matthew 7:15-20. What was the main idea Jesus was trying to get across?
- Why do you think Jesus moves from his discussion of the wide and narrow way to a warning about false prophets?
- Jesus described such false prophets as being like “wolves in sheep’s clothing.” What does that mean? What does that look like in real life?
- How did Jesus advise his listeners to deal with false teachers? How do we spot them so we can avoid them?
- In Matthew 7:16-20, Jesus talked a lot about trees and fruit. How does Matthew 12:33-35 correlate with what Jesus taught in the Sermon on the Mount?
- What type of fruit do good teacher’s produce? What type of fruit, produced by false teachers, reveals a problem?
- Why are some false teachers so convincing? What are some of their “tricks” to getting an audience with true followers of Jesus?
