The situation with Bless China Int'l is much the same. The work continues...with much fruit and joy among our staff and the children and families they serve. Three of our doctors and their families returned in October and are settled back in Kunming. New, more rigid requirements for re-entry to China were just put into place November 1st, so we will face that hurdle when we try to return to Kunming after the Chinese New Year.

Noelani is now several weeks post operative from her back surgery. The first two weeks were very trying and painful but in week 3 things turned a corner and she was able to get therapy from an awesome physical therapist who also treated Rob when he had his back surgery a few years ago. She was able to get released for travel to Canada to be with her brother, Ray, who was in his last days due to spread of his cancer. The Lord provided for this trip in several marvelous ways. They had a short two days together but it was a sweet time and she was able to love and minister and comfort him.
