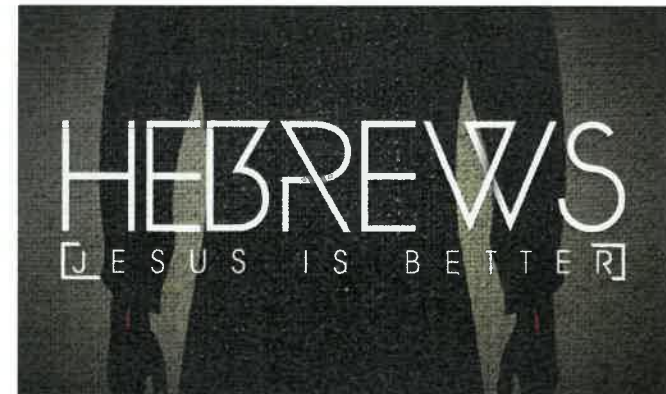

3. What exhortation is given in Hebrews 6:1-2? What are the elementary principles of Christianity according to the author?
4. Verses 4-8 have debated for centuries! Take a look and come up with what you believe to be the possible explanation for this teaching.
5. After giving the warning of Hebrews 6:4-8, how does the author seek to bring comfort in verses 9-12.
6. Looking back on the entire teaching of Hebrews 5:11-6:12, what do you think is the goal of the writer? How can this teaching minister to you today?
