
What is the “Jesus of the Gospels” all about?

Message Reflection Questions

- Do you have a favorite gospel book? Do you have a penchant for Matthew, Mark, Luke or John? What draws you to this particular book?
- In the message Pastor Kurt talked about the 3 offices Jesus holds: prophet, priest and king. How would you explain these three offices to someone who didn't know much about Jesus?
- How is Jesus' kingdom different than the kingdoms of the world? How did Jesus seek to communicate the differences in Luke 17:20 and Matthew 18:36? Ultimately, what is it that Jesus seeks to rule over?
- What does it mean that Jesus serves people as a priest? What did Jesus do to bring peace between God and humans? Why do we need a mediator to build a bridge between us and God? According to 1 Timothy 2:5, who is the only one who can serve as our mediator?
- Jesus also holds the office of prophet. What is it that prophets do? How did Jesus fulfill the role of prophet during His ministry? Why is Jesus the “ultimate” prophet?
- Why are the accounts of the gospels so important to us? What if our Bibles lacked the gospels?
- Can the offices of Jesus be separated? Can we say we want Jesus to be our priest but refuse Him as King?
