Many things are going on around our lives and our ministry. We praise God for the several opportunities we have to teach His Word in order to build up His church as a local body. In March, I was invited to preach in a fellowship with several churches. Vanessa was teaching as well. She taught kids and the wives of the pastors and other leaders (in Swahili!) It was a great day!

A few weeks ago we were with my friend, Biotto, in the north of Tanzania. He works with addicts and alcoholic people who are willing to be changed by the Word of God. I was able to share the Word with all of them. It was a special time!

We have started the process to renew our VISA. This is usually a complicated and long process but it seems that things are getting easier. We were asked to bring some other documents from Mexico, so they are on the way to Tanzania. Hopefully we will have everything by next week so we can go to talk to the government people to introduce our case.

### Prayer Needs


- Please pray for all of our local pastors and churches, for the Word of God to be preached in truth and for lives to be transformed.
