- Paul's concern: The church at Corinth was rapidly losing its T\_\_\_\_\_ in that city.
- The big issue at hand: Instead of working out their problems with one another, the Corinthians were dragging each another off to the C\_\_\_\_\_ C\_\_\_\_\_.
- The fact that the Corinthians were taking legal action against one another was a sure sign of S\_\_\_\_\_ D\_\_\_\_\_.
- William MacDonald: "It is much better to R\_\_\_\_\_ a wrong than to C\_\_\_\_\_ one."
- The big question to grapple with: Is there anything in our heart that is overly C\_\_\_\_\_ and U\_\_\_\_\_?
